My recent project was adding a cocking handle to the left side of an AR-15 upper. (See Pictures 1, 2, and 3). This required slotting the upper, and installing a handle and fitting a handle to the carrier. A significant lesson learned was how to locate the ends of the slot that is cut in the left side of the upper.

Benefits include getting the job done right, getting it done on schedule, and learning. Using professional tools will identify the right tools to buy, if you want to. Also, the range is right there for function firing and fine tuning before you leave.
